

ORDINANCE NO. 62.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING INDECENT EXPOSURE OF STALLION, JACK, BULL OR OTHER ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

: Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Indecent exposure of animals prohibited. Any person who shall be guilty of making or permitting an indecent exposure or exhibition, within the limits of the City of Polson, of any stallion, jack, bull, or other animals, shall on conviction pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.
