

ORDINANCE NO. 111.

AN ORDINANCE OF AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 9 PROVIDING FOR THE MUZZLING OF DOGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1. Between June 15th and September 15th inclusive of each year each and every dog within the limits of the City of Polson shall be provided with a muzzle the same to be properly fitted and securely fastened to the said dog while off the premises of the owner or harbinger of that particular dog.

Section 2. Between June 15th and September 15th inclusive of each year, it shall be the duty of the Chief of Police to take up, impound and dispose of according to the provisions of law all dogs without a properly fitting muzzle found off the premises of the owner or harbinger of the said dog.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and approval.

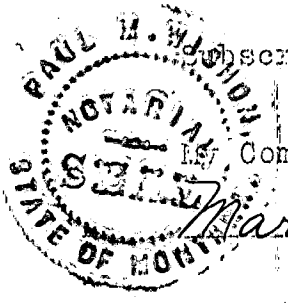
