

ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

SECTION 1 - The compensation of the Mayor, Aldermen, City Clerk, City Treasurer, City Attorney, Police Judge, Health Officer, Street Commissioner, Water Commissioner, Chief of Police, Chief of Fire Department, Assistant Chief of Fire Department, Assistant Water Commissioner and Assistant Chief of Police, Night Police and Watchman, is hereby fixed and established at the following named salaries; and that the same shall be accepted and taken as full compensation for all services to be rendered by said officers for the City of Polson:

Mayor.....	None
Aldermen.....	None
City Clerk.....	\$25.00 per month
City Treasurer.....	8.33 per month
City Attorney.....	None-except when specially employed.
Police Judge.....	8.33 per month
Health Officer.....	4.16 per month
Street Commissioner.....	41.66 per month
Water Commissioner.....	41.66 per month
Asst. Water Com & Collector.....	40.00 per month
Chief of Police.....	41.66 per month
Night Police & Watchman.....	85.00 per month
Fire Chief (when present).....	1.50 per call
Asst. Fire Chief (when present).....	1.50 per call
Firemen (when present).....	1.00 per call
Librarian.....	30.00 per month

SECTION 2 - The said several salaries shall be paid at the end of each month, by the order of the City Council and approval of the Mayor.

SECTION 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
