AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 145 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, THAT

SECTION I

Ordinance Number 145 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION II - PAYMENT OF WATER RENTAL All bills for water, whether by flat rate or meter, are due and payable at the office of the Water Department the first day of each month for all water used the preceding month rirst day of each month for all water used the preceding month and will become delinquent on the 10th day of the month and a ten per cent (10%) penalty will be added to the amount due; and if still delinquent on the 15th day of the month the Water Commissioner shall at his discretion, shut off the water and it shall not be turned on until all bills are paid, including an additional charge of \$1.00 for turning on. Owners of the property served will be held liable for all water and service charges. Payments will be accepted from tenants, but will not relieve the owner if tenant becomes delinquent.

SECTION III

WHEREAS, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the city of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
