

## ORDINANCE No. 151

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND DISCONTINUING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF LAKE STREET AND THIRD STREET IN THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA ORIGINAL TOWNSITE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the city council of the city of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. It appearing to the satisfaction of the council that all proper and necessary notice had been given of the petition of Frank G. Swanberg for the closing and vacating of certain portions of Third Street and Lake Street in the original townsite of the city of Polson, Montana, as required by law.

Section 2. It is hereby ordered by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that the following parts or portions of Lake Street and Third Street in the original townsite of the City of Polson, Montana be closed, vacated and discontinued; said parts or portions being described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at the south east corner of Block Four of the original townsite of Polson, Montana; thence northeasterly 212 feet more or less, to the south corner of the triangular Public Reserve; thence north along the west line of said Public Reserve 117.2 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of said Public Reserve; thence southwesterly to the north corner of Block Four of original townsite of Polson, Montana; thence due west to the meander line of Flathead Lake; thence southwesterly along the meander line of Flathead Lake to the point of intersection of said meander line with the north line of "B" Street; thence east along the north line of "E" Street 140.1 feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of Block Four, original townsite of Polson, Montana; thence northeasterly along the west line of said Block Four to the north corner of said Block Four; thence south along the east line of said Block Four to the place of beginning.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after its final passage and approval.
