ORDINANCE No. 157

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 128 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, ESTABLISHING A SYSTEM OF STREETS, SIDE WALKS AND GRADES.

WHEREAS, The city of Polson, by its duly authorized City Council, has heretofore passed Ordinance No. 128, which, among other things, prescribes the width of side walks and the width of parking in Grandview Addition to the city of Polson together with other additions to the city of Polson; and

WHEREAS, the city council has been petitioned to change the width of the sidewalks provided in said Ordinance for Grandview Addition and the width of the parking provided in said Ordinance for Grandview Addition.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the city council of the City of Polson, Montana that section 10 of Ordinance No. 128 be amended and the same is hereby amended and prescribes that in Grandview Addition to the city of Polson the sidewalks shall be four feet wide and two feet from the property line and the parking shall be Eleven feet wide and that the same applies to all streets running east and west and north and south in Grandview Addition to the City of Polson.

That all ordinances in conflict with this provision are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that the property owners in Grandview Addition to the city of Polson are desirous of commencing work on their streets and sidewalks: THEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
