ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 152 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Polson, Montana.

That section 1 of Ordinance No. 152 of the city of Polson, Montana be amended so as to read as follows:-

The loundaries
Section 1. The boundaries of the inner fire limits of the
city of Polson, shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of "A" and Fourth Streets in the criginal townsite of Polson; thence east 150 feet to the center line of
Block Six(6); thence south on center line of Blocks Six (6),
Nine (9), Fifteen (15) and Eighteen (18) original townsite
of Polson to "E" Street; thence west on "E" street to alley
running north and south through Block Twenty (20) original
townsite of Polson; thence north on the alley to "B" street;
thence west to city limits; thence in a northeasterly
direction following city limits to west end of "A" street;
thence east on "A" street to its intersection with Fourth
Street the place of beginning.

Section 2. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the city of Polson this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
