ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD OF OILING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 5, AND OF PAYING FOR THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, to-wit:

SECTION 1 - That all of the streets included within oil sprinkling District No. 5 shall be oiled during the summer season of 1932 by forces employed by the city.

SECTION 2 - That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of the property, exclusive of parks and public places, embraced within such sprinkling district on a combination linear and area basis.

SECTION 3 - Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
