ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 159 OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 159 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. No vehicle shall travel at a speed faster than twenty-five miles per hour on any street in the City of Polson, provided however, that the maximum speed limit shall not be greater than twelve miles per hour when passing school buildings or houses or upon any street or streets of the City of Polson designated as a School Zone, when and where signs, posts or other markers so direct or indicate. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit the officers, men, apparatus or vehicles of the fire department of the City of Polson from proceeding at such rate of speed as may be necessary for the proper discharge of their respective duties."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and posting according to law.
