

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 22 OF ORDINANCE #14 OF THE CITY
OF POLSON RELATING TO LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City council of the City of Polson:

Section 1: That Section 22 of Ordinance #14 of the City of Polson be amended to read as follows:

"Section 22. Every person practicing a profession as lawyer, dentist, physician, surgeon or resident or studio photographer or any other profession or any insurance agent must pay licenses of \$5.00 per annum and an itinerant or transient photographer must pay a license of \$5.00 per day. Any person who draws any legal instrument or paper for which a fee is charged or money paid is practicing a profession under this subdivision. A resident or studio photographer, for the purposes of this ordinance, is hereby defined as any person, firm or corporation engaging in the business of portrait and or commercial photography or enlargements who has established, conducts and maintains a permanent studio or place of business in the City of Polson, Montana. An itinerant or transient photographer is hereby defined as any photographer, picture or view taker, coupon salesman, enlargement solicitor or canvasser therefor and or any person, firm, or corporation who shall take, peddle, sell or deliver any negatives, films, photographs, prints or enlargements within the limits of the city of Polson; or a studio photographer, as such is defined herein, who does not conduct and maintain a studio or permanent place of business."

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the council, approval by the Mayor and due posting.
