

## ORDINANCE NO. 180

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN BUSES,  
TRUCKS OR VEHICLES UPON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY  
OF POLSON, AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION  
THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any truck, bus or other vehicle having a wheel base longer than one hundred thirty-three (133) inches or any truck or other vehicle having a bed longer than eight (8) feet at any place on Third Street between "D" and "B" Streets, or on "B" Street Between Third and Fourth streets, except while engaged in loading or unloading passengers or commodities of any description, and then only for a period of time not exceeding fifteen (15) minutes.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be subject to a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval.
