## ORDINANCE NO. 189

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I OF ORDINANCE NO. 167 REGULATING AND FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF POLSON, MONTANA.

SECTION I. That Section I of Ordinance No. 167 be amended to read as follows: The compensation of the City Clerk City Treasurer, City Attorney, Police Judge, Health Officer, Street Commissioner, Water Commissioner, Auditor of Improvement District Taxes, is hereby fixed and established at the following named salaries; and that the same shall be accepted and taken as full compensation for all services to be rendered by said officers for the City of Polson:

SECTION 2. The said several salaries shall be paid at the end of each month by the order of the City Council and approval of the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
