## ORDINANCE NO. 199

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 658 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON? MONTANA, NO. 191, RELATED TO POSTERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1. That Section 658 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No. 191, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 658. SAME-POSTERS? ETC. PROHIBITED. No person shall post, paste, paint or affix any a- placard, campaign card, bill, notice or sign upon any structure or thing within any part of any park or public grounds, nor upon or to any lamp, electric, telephone or telegraph pole within the corporate limits of the City of Polson.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3; The Council hereby declares that an emergency exists and therefore this ordinance shall be in full force ans effect immediately after its passage and approval.
