

ORDINANCE NO 215

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE LICENSING FEE FOR SELLING BEER AT RETAIL IN THE CITY OF POLSON, DECLARATION THAT THE LICENSES OR FEES ARE REASONABLE, REPEALING PARTS OF ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

Section 1. Each beer license in the city of Polson shall pay an annual license fee as follows:

Each retailer the sum of \$200.00
Each club the sum of \$50.00

Section 2. Such parts of any other ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and superseded.

Section 3. That the license fees provided for in section 1, herein, are hereby declared reasonable and not in excess of the amounts imposed by the state.

Section 4. That an emergency exists herein necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety, welfare and preservation of law and order in the city of Polson, and to its inhabitants, requiring that this ordinance become effective upon its passage and approval.

Section 5. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and approval, if not 30 days thereafter its passage and approval.
