

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD FOR OILING THE STREETS WITHIN OILING DISTRICT NO. 14-K, PAYING FOR THE SAME AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

SECTION 1. That all of the streets included within oiling District No. 14-K shall be oiled during the summer of the oiling season of 1953 for forces employed by the City of Polson.

SECTION 2. That the cost and expenses of oil sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of the said property, exclusive of public parks and public places, embraced within such oiling district upon an area basis and which cost shall be approximately \$7.50 per lot.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS: An emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public and the inhabitants of the City of Polson, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Passed by the City Council of the City of Polson and approved by the Mayor this 6th day of April, 1953.

ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD FOR SPRINKLING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14-L PAYING FOR THE SAME AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

SECTION 1. That all of the streets included within Oil District No. 14-L shall be sprinkled with oil during the summer season of 1953 by forces of the city of Polson.

SECTION 2. That the cost and expenses of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of the property, exclusive of public parks and public places, embraced within such oil sprinkling district upon an area basis, and which cost shall be approximately \$2.50 per lot.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS: An emergency exists, and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
