

RESOLUTION NO. 178

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, TO INVEST AVAILABLE MONEY IN THE SPECIAL WATER REVENUE FUND OF 1960 AND A SPECIAL RESERVE FUND OF 1960 IN APPROVED SECURITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, THAT:

WHEREAS IT APPEARS TO THE CITY COUNCIL that there is now available money in the Special Water Revenue Fund of 1960 and the Special Reserve Fund of 1960 over and above the amount required for the paying of principal and interest, becoming due on the next interest payment date, sufficient to pay and redeem one or more outstanding bonds of the issue or series to which such sinking funds belong; and

WHEREAS, it further appears to the best interest of said City of Polson, Montana, to invest such surplus funds in approved interest-bearing securities; and;

WHEREAS, it appears that the City of Polson does not have any available funds which can be legally invested in any of the bonds specified, and, therefore, said City can not purchase any of the outstanding bonds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer be, and he hereby is, authorized to invest the available money in either of said funds in other bonds of the City, Warrants of the City, in warrants issued by any Country of the State, in bonds or warrants of this State, or in bonds or treasury Certificates of the United States; provided, however, that such funds shall only be invested in such securities as such will become due and payable at least 30 days before the date when the bonds of the City of such series become redeemable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of fifteen hundred dollars per month from the Water Fund to the Special Water Revenue Fund of 1960 for the purpose of making investments and the transfers heretofore made under oral direction are hereby confirmed, ratified and approved.

ORDINANCE NO. 2 66

(See title, P398)

BE IT ANACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1: From and after the passage and approval of this ordinance, no licensee or his or her employee or employees, nor any other person, shall sell, deliver, or give away, or cause or permit to be sold, delivered or given away any intoxicating liquor, beer or wine to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.

Section 2. Any minor, or other person who knowingly misrepresents his or her qualifications for the purpose of abating intoxicating liquor, beer, or wine from any such licensee or other person, shall be equally guilty with such licensee or other person and shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalties hereinafter set forth.

SECTION #. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or may be imprisoned in the City jail not to exceed thirty (30) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. Any person who invites a person under the age of twenty-one years (21) into a public place where liquor is sold and treats, gives or purchases liquor for such person, or permits such person in a public place where liquor is sold to treat give or purchase liquor for him, or holds out such person to be over the age of twenty-one years (21) to the owner of the liquor establishment, or his or her employee, or employees, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and punished as hereinbefore provided.

Section 5: An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
