A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA CONFIRMING AND APPROVING THE SALE OF THE BONDS OF SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 20 OF THE CITY OF POLSON

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

WHEREAS, BY Resolution of the City Council No.177, duly passed and approved on the 6th day of June, 1960, Special Improvement District Bonds of the said Special Improvement District Number 20, of the City of Polson, were authorized and the form thereof adopted and approved; AND

WHEREAS, thereafter, Notice of Sale of said bonds were duly published as provided by law, and the date of the sale of said Bonds having been fixed for October 3rd., 1960, at 7:30 P.M. at the City Hall in Polson, Montana; AND,

ORDINANCE No. 266

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE, DELIVERY OR GIVING AWAY OF ANY INTOXICATING LIQUOR, BEER OR WINE TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE YEARS (21) AND MAKING ANY PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE (21) WHO MISREPRESENTS HIS OR HER AGE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING INTOXICATING LIQUOR, BEER OR WINE GUILTY OF a misdemeanor; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE No. 267

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY ELECTIVE AND APPOINTIVE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBER 250 and 251, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION 1: That the salaries of the following elective officers are hereby fixed as follows:

The salary of th Mayor; \$25.00 per month.
Th salary of each alderman; \$15.00 per month
The salary of th City Treasurer; \$95.00 per month.
Th salary of the Police Judge; \$50.00 per month.

SECTION 2: The salaries of the appointiv officers ~~will~~ shall be as follows:

Chief of Police, \$365.00 per month
 City Clerk; \$335.00 per month
 City Attorney; \$75.00 per month.

SECTION 3: Ordinances 250 and 251 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after July 1, 1961.

ORDINANCE NO. 268

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 316, 317 and 329 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, No. 191, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 198 RELATING TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION I. That Section 316 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No. 191, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 316. Same. Where parallel parking is permitted, no vehicle shall be parked within twenty (20) feet of the property line of any intersection of streets or avenues nor within ten (10) feet of the property line at the intersection of any alley and street or avenue. Said distances to be measured back from the property line and along the curb line.

SECTION 2. Same. That Section 317 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No. 191, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 317. Same. Where angle parking is required, no vehicle parked, shall be at any street, avenue, or alley intersection within ten (10) feet of the property line when parking on the near side of such intersection or within twenty (20) feet of the property line when parking on the far side of ~~the~~ such intersection."

SECTION 3. That Section 329 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No. 191, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 329. Same. It shall be unlawful for any purpose to park any automobile, motor vehicle, or other convenience of any kind for any period of more than one (1) hour between 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., upon Main Street from 2nd. Avenue to 5th. Avenue, and on the west side of Main Street seventy-five (75) feet north of 2nd Avenue; 3rd Avenue from the alley in Bl. 13, Orig. to the east line of lot 9, Bl. 9 Orig.; 2nd Avenue from the 2nd Avenue bridge to the railroad tracks at approximately 5th Street East; 4th Avenue from Main Street ~~East~~ to 1st. Street East; 5th Avenue from Main Street to 1st. Street East. No vehicle, as above described, shall be parked more than fifteen (15) minutes at any time one 1st. Street East and 3rd Ave adjacent to the United States Post Office. No parking of such vehicles shall be permitted on Main Street between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M. between 7th Avenue and a point seventy-five (75) feet north of 2nd. Avenue.

Section 2. From and after the passage of this Ordinance, all Motor vehicles parking upon any portion of 2nd Avenue, within the city limits of Polson, Montana, shall park parallel with the curb, in the manner designated in the Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana. Parking on all other streets and Avenues within the City shall be diagonal, in the manner designated in the Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
