

ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE JOB DESIGNATIONS OF STREET SUPERINTENDENT, WATER SUPERINTENDENT, ASSISTANT WATER SUPERINTENDENT, PARK SUPERINTENDENT, AND DEPUTY TO THE CITY CLERK--AND WATER-COLLECTOR; FIXING THEIR SALARIES; PROVIDING AN INDEMNITY BOND FOR THE DEPUTY CITY CLERK AND WATER COLLECTOR; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

BE IT ORDNANIED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA;

## SECTION 1. STREET SUPERINTENDENT:-

- (a) There is hereby created the job designation of Street Superinfntendent.
- (b) The Street Superintendent shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.
- (c) Salary:- The salary of the Street Superintendent shall be Three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) per month.
- (d) Duties:- The duties of the Street Superintendent shall be the maintenance and construction of streets and alleys, and such other duties as may be determined by the Mayor and Council.

## SECTION 2. WATER SUPERINTENDENT.

- (a) There is hereby created the job designation of Water Superintendent.
- (b) Appointement shall be by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council
- (c) Salary- The salary of the Water Superintendent shall be Four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month and shall be retro-active to July 1st., 1961.
- (d) Duties- The duties of the Water Superintendent shall be the supervision and maintenance of the City Water System, and such other duties as may be assigned by the Mayor and Council.

## SECTION 3. PARK SUPERINTENDENT.

- (a) There is hereby created the job designation of Park Superintendent.
- (b) Appointment shall be by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.
- (c) Salary- The salary of the Park Superintendent shall be Two hundred fifty (\$250.00) per month, plus house and utilities.
- (d) Duties- The duties of the Park Superintendent shall be the care and maintenance of City Parks, excepting only the municipal golf course during the golf season, and such other duties as may be assigned by the Mayor and Council.

## SECTION 4. DEPUTY TO THE CITY-CLERK-AND-WATER-COLLECTOR

- (a) There is hereby created the job designation of Deputy-to-the-City-Clerk-and Water-collector.
- (b) Appointment shall be by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.
- (c) Salary- The salary of the Deputy-City-Clerk-and-Water-Collector shall be Two hundred seventy five (\$275.00) per month and shall be retro-active to July 1st., 1961.
- (d) Duties; The duties of the Deputy City-Clerk-and-Water-Collector shall be to assist the City Clerk and Water Collector, to act in the usual capacity of a "Deputy" and as the Mayor and Council may determine.
- (e) Indemnity Bond- The Deputy-City-Clerk-and-Water-Collector shall have an indemnity bond in the princiapl sum of Ten Thousand Dollards (\$10,000.00), conditioned as in the case of the City Clerk and Water Collector, which shall be procured and approved in the usual manner.

## SECTION 5. ASSISTANT WATER SUPERINTENDENT.

- (a) There is hereby created the job designation of Assistant Water Superint ndent.
- (b) The Assistant Water Superintendent shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council
- (c) Salary- The salary of the Assistant Water Superintendent shall be Three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per month.
- (d) Duties- The duties of the Assistant Water Superintendent shall be to assist the Water Superintendent, as as the Mayor and Council may det rmine.

## SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

## SECTION 7. DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

An Emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the imm diate preservation of the public peace, h alth, and safety, and therefor , this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 272

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY CLERK AND WATER COLLECTOR, THE CHIEF OF POLICE, AND THE FIRE CHIEF, REPEALING SECTION 2, OF THE ORDINANCE NUMBER 267 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES, AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE AS OF JULY 1st,, 1961, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION 1. That the salaries and wages of the following officers, appointe s, of the City of Polson, shall be fixed as hereinafter provided.

- (a) City Clerk and Water Collector- The salary of the City Clerk and Water Collector shall be Three Hundred seventy five dollars (375.00) per month effective July 1st., 1961.
- (b) Chief of Police- The salary of the Chief of Police shall be Four Hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month effective July 1st., 1961.
- (c) Fire Chief- The Salary of the Fire Chief shall be continued at the present rate of Seventy Five dollars (\$75.00) per month.

SECTION 2. Repealing Clause- Section 2, of Ordinance No. 267, and all other Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. "Emergency Clause; An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 273

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY DIRECTOR OF CIVIL DEFENSE, APPOINTING A DIRECTOR, AND DEFINING HIS DUTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That this Ordinance be known as the Civil Defense Plan.

Section 2. That Ellen T. Wiedman, Director, Lake County, Montana, Civil Defense, be and she is hereby appointed City Director of Civil Defense to have direct responsibility for the organization, administration and operation of the City Organization for Civil Defense.

SECTION 3. That said director, or her successor in office, be and she or he is hereby empowered in case of natural disaster or subversive action or enemy action to use any City equipment of any kind or description and that she, or he may call upon any or all employees of the City of Polson to assist her or him, particularly those in charge of maintenance and operation of such equipment; and that no further authority shall be required for such City Director of Civil Defense to act, and that this appointment be effective immediately from and after said director taking and filing the prescribed oath of office.
