ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CITY ELECTIVE AND APPOINTIVE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBER 250 AND 251, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1: That the salaries of the following elective officers are hereby fixed as follows:

The salary of the Mayor; \$125.00 per month.

The salary of each Alderman; \$28.00 per month.

The salary of City Treasurer; \$100.00 per month.

The salary of Police Judge; \$60.00 per month.

Section 2: The salaries of the appointive officers shall be as follows, but shall be subject to change by the City Council from time to time as permitted by statute:

Water and Street Commissioner; \$ per month.

Assistant Water and Street Commissioner; \$ per month.

Chief of Police; \$ Per Month.

One full-time Policeman; \$ per month.

City Clerk; \$ per month.

City Attorney; \$100.00 per month.

Chief of the Fire Department; \$ per month.

Section 3: The salaries of all other appointers and employees shall be fixed in the amounts and for the times as may be, from time to time, determined by the City Council.

Section 4: Ordinances No. 250-25/ and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after July 1, 1963.
