

Section 3. Whenever any child under the age of eighteen (18) years shall unlawfully operate a motor vehicle in the presence of any peace officer of the city, such officer may deliver to said child a form of summons describing the nature of the offense, with instructions thereon to report to the police court of the city, and the court shall be informed thereof the delivery of a copy of said summons to the probation officer, who shall in turn deliver the same to the judge or justice of peace.

Section 4. The City Council hereby declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of Polson and, therefore, shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval.

Section 5. All acts, and parts of acts, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 288.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF SOME OF THE APPOINTIVE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Section 1. That the salaries of the following appointive officers of the City of Polson are hereby fixed as follows, but shall be subject to change from time to time as may be permitted by statute;


Water and Street Commissioner	- - -	#400.00 per month.
Ass. Water & Street Commissioner	- -	350.00 per month.
Chief of Police	- - - - -	400.00 per month.
One full time Policeman	- - - - -	350.00 per month.
City Clerk,	- - - - -	375.00 per month.
Chief of Fire Department,	- - - - -	75.00 per month.

Section 2. The salaries of all other appointees and employees shall be fixed in the amounts and for the times as may be, from time to time, determined by the City Council.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. The Council hereby declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of Polson and, therefore, shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval.
