## ORDINANCE NO. 290.

AN ORDINANCE FOR REVISING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, PROVIDING FOR PERPETUAL CODIFICATION; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN PROVIDING CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON,

Section 1: That all ordinances of general nature in force in the City of Polson, Montana as revised, codified, and compiled and hereinafter set forth, be and they are hereby adopted, passed, published, and declared to be the compiled ordinances of the City of Polson, Momtana, and that said compiled ordinances shall be referred to and cited as

the "CITY CODE OF POLSON, 1965".

Section 2: There is hereby adopted as a method of perpetual codification. the loose leaf type of binding, togather with a continuous supplemental service, whereby each newly adopted ordinance of a general nature amending, altering, adding to, or deleting provisions of the Municipal Code, is identified by the proper catch line and is inserted in the proper place in each of the official copies. Each such insertion shall be made within thirty (30) days following the

date of adoption by the Council.

Section 3: That at least one (1) official copy of said official Municipal Code of the City of Polson, Montana, shall at all times be on file and available for inspection in the

office of the City Clerk.

Section 4: All Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed as set forth in Title 1, Chapter 2, herein. Section 5: That this Ordinance and all said ordinances of a general nature compiled and codified as above stated, shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after the passage and approval of this ordinance.
