AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-3-1 of ORDINANCE NO. 290, REVISED CODES OF POLSON, L($\phi\%$. BY DELETING THAT PORTION OF THE SECTION PERTAINING TO PUNISHMENT FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION OF RECKLESS DRIVING, AND AMENDING THE PENALTY FOR FIRST CONVICTION.

Every person convicted of reckless driving shall be punished upon conviction by imprisonment for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, or by a fine of not less than twenty-five and no/100ths Dollars (425.00) nor more than Three Hundred and mo/100ths Dollars (\$300.00) or both such fine and imprisonment.

ORDINANCE NO. 300.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-4-1 (C) of ORDINANCE NO. 290, REVISED CODES OF POLSON, L965. BY DELETING THAT PORTION OF THE SECTION PERTAINING TO PUNISHMENT FOR SECOND OFFENCES OF DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOX_ICATING LIQUOR OR DRUGS.

ORDINANCE NO. 301.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-1-3 of ORDINANCE NO. 290, REVISED CODES OF POLSON, 1965, DEFINING THE CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON. MONTANA:

SECTION 6-1-3 of Ordinance No. 290, Revised Codes of Polson, 1865, shall be amended to read as follows:

ASSAULT OR BATTERY: Every person who commits an Assault or an Assault and Battery, not such as is specified in R.C.M., 1947, Sections 94-601 and 94-602, is guilty of Assault in the Third Degree and is punishable by imprisonment in the County Jail not more than ninety (90) days, or by a fine not more than Three Hundred and no/100ths Dollars (\$300.00), or both,
