

ORDINANCE NO. 302.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-3-13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 290, REVISED CODES OF POLSON, 1965, PROHIBITING DOGS FROM RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA FROM MARCH 7, 1967 to APRIL 7, 1967.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION 6-3-13 of Ordinance No. 290, Revised Codes of Polson, 1965, shall be amended to read as follows:

No dog shall be permitted to run at large within the City of Polson from March 7, 1967 to April 7, 1967.

ORDINANCE NO. 303.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-5-6- (13) of ORDINANCE NO. 290, REVISED CODES OF POLSON, 1965, BY PERMITTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REAL ESTATE AND INSURANCE OFFICES IN "B" RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS UPON THE FILING OF THE WRITTEN CONSENTS OF THE OWNERS OF NOT LESS THAN SEVENTY-FIVE PER CENT (75%) OF THE PROPERTY WITHIN A DISTANCE OF TWO HUNDRED FEET (200 ft) from the lot upon WHICH THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT IS TO BE ERECTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION 11-5-6- (13) of Ordinance No. 290, Revised Codes of Polson, 1965, shall be amended to read as follows:

Either a public garage, filling station, real estate office or insurance office may be established or erected in this district if, when the permit is issued, there is on file with the building inspector, the written consent of the owners of not less than Seventy-Five per cent (75%) of all the property within a distance of Two Hundred feet (200 ft.) of the lot upon which the proposed establishment is to be erected; provided, that the real estate occupied by a garage, filling station, real estate office or insurance office within Two Hundred feet (200 ft.) distance, shall not count either for or against such consent.
