ORDINANCE NO. 305

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-2-4 (A) of CITY CODE OF POLSON, 1965, TO PROVIDE SPEED LIMITS IN DESIGNATED CITY PARKS, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON,

Section 10-2-4 (A) of the City Code of Polson, 1965 shall be amended by the addition of subsection 8, which shall be as follows;

FIFTEEN (15) MILES PER HOUR WHILE OPERATING ANY MOTOR VEHICLE IN OR UPON ANY ROADWAY LOCATED WITHIN RIVERSIDE PARK: POLSON GOLF COURSE, INCLUDING THE COUNTRY CLUB, SWIMING BEACH AND PICNIC AREA, AND SACAJAWEA PARK.

REPEALING CLAUSE, All Ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY, An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
