ORDINANCE # 318

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 10 OF THE CITY CODE OF POLSON, 1965, BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 10-2-12 (F) MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO DELIVER FREIGHT FROM CITY STREETS AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, IN VEHICLES OF A GREATER THAN ONE (1) TON CAPACITY.

BE IT ORDANINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Chapter 2 of Title 10 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by the addition of Section 10-2-12 (F) which shall read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to deliver freight from any vehicle parked upon the streets and alleys of the City of Polson, Montana, which shall have a factory designated hauling capacity of greater than one (1) ton. It shall continue to be lawful for any person, firm or corporation to deliver freight within the city limits of the City of Polson, Montana, by vehicles of greater than one (1) ton hauling capacity provided that such vehicles shall be parked, at the time of loading and unloading, entirely on the customers' private parking. Provided further, however, that delivery of entire truck loads of merchandise may be made from vehicles of a larger than one (1) ton capacity provided that prior arrangements for such street or alley delivery shall have been made with the Chief of Police of the City of Polson, Montana.

REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY. An Emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
