ORDINANCE NO. 343

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE I OF THE CITY CODE OF POLSON, 1965, BY PROVIDING FOR INCREASED SALARIES FOR ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICERS AND PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYEE'S WAGES: REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, deems the current salary schedule for the elected and appointed officers of the City of Polson, Montana, to be inadequate at the present time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

That Chapter 7 of Title of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by amending Subsection 1, thereof, which shall read as follows:

1-7-1: ELECTIVE OFFICERS: The Elective Officers of the City of Polson and their salaries shall be as follows:

Mayor	\$180.00 per month
Alderman	\$ 50.00 per meeting
Treasurer	\$150.00 per month
Police Judge	\$105.00 per month

No additional compensation shall be allowed.

That Chapter 7 of Title 1 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by amending Subsection 2 thereof, which shall read as follows:

1-7-2: APPOINTIVE OFFICERS: That Appointive Officers of the City of Polson and their salaries shall be as follows:

City Attorney	\$280.00 per month
City Clerk	\$615.00 per month
Water Superintendent	\$650.00 per month
Sewer Superintendent	\$650.00 per month
Street Superintendent	\$650.00 per month
Park Superintendent	\$600.00 per month
Fire Chief-Building	
Inspector	\$650.00 per month
Chief of Police	\$700.00 per month

That Chapter 7 of Title 1 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by amending Subsection 3 thereof, which shall read as follows;

1-7-3: EMPLOYEE'S WAGES: All other persons drawing salaries from the City of Polson shall be classified as "employees," whose salaries shall be fixed, from time to time, by Council action.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and approval.
