

ORDINANCE NO. 352

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 351 BY RENUMBERING SECTION 5-8-23 AS 5-8-23(a) AND ADDING SECTION 5-8-23(b); REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Chapter 8 of Title 5 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by renumbering Section 5-8-23 as 5-8-23(a) and by the addition of Section 5-8-23 (b) which shall read as follows:

Section 5-8-23 (b): Only one application fee shall be required in the situation where the applicant for a dealer's license is also the applicant for a gambling license, it being the intention of the governing body that one investigation per individual is all that it shall require. This does not, however, eliminate the requirement that both applications be filed where both licenses are sought.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and approval.
