ORDINANCE NO. 353

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 6-1-3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, AND DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF ASSAULT AS IS CITED BELOW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Ordinance Number 6-1-3 of Chapter 6 of the City Code of Polson, shall be amended to be read as follows;

Section 6-1-3; ASSAULT: A person commits the offense of assault if he:

- (a) Purposely or knowlngly causes sbodily injury to another; or
- (b) Negligently causes bodily injury to another with a weapon; or
- (c) Purposely or knowingly makes physical contact of an insulting
- or provoding nature with any individual; or (d) Purposely or knowingly causes reasonable apprehension of bodily injury in another. The purpose to cause reasonable apprehension or the knowledge that reasonable apprehension would be caused shall be presumed in any case in which a person knowingly points a firearm at or in the direction of another whether or not the offender believes the firearm to be loaded.

and is guilty of Assault in the Third Degree and is punishable by improsonment in the County Jail not more than ninety (90) days, or by fine not more that Three Hundred and no/100ths Dollars (\$300.00) or both.
