

ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SEVEN OF TITLE ONE OF THE CITY CODE OF POLSON, 1965, BY PROVIDING FOR INCREASED SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS: REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, deemed the current salary schedule for appointed officers of the City of Polson, Montana, to be inadequate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

That Chapter 7 of Title 1 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended by amending Subsection 2 thereof, which shall read as follows:

City Attorney	\$308.00 per month
City Clerk	\$715.00 per month
Water Superintendent	\$750.00 per month
Sewer Superintendent	\$750.00 per month
Street Superintendent	\$750.00 per month
Park Superintendent	\$750.00 per month
Chief of Police	\$820.00 per month
F Fire Chief-Building Inspector	\$750.00 per month

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 358

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY PROVIDING FOR A REVISED LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

Section 6 of Chapter 6 of Title V of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall be amended to read as follows:

5 5-6-6: REQUIREMENTS; LICENSE FEES: A Person who desires to engage in the business of manufacturing, selling or distribution of beer in said City under provision of State Law in the character of places hereinafter mentioned, shall, notwithstanding the fact that the person conducting such place has obtained a license from the Montana Liquor Control Board, first apply for and obtain a license therefor from said City, as herein provided, and if such license is granted, shall pay therefor an annual license fee as follows:

Retail Liquor	\$250.00
Retail Beer	\$100.00
Fraternal Organizations	\$100.00
Any unit of a nationally	
Chartered Veterans Organization	\$ 25.00

If any license issued by the Montana Liquor Control Board under the provision of the "Montana Beer Act" shall be revoked or shall be suspended, the accompanying license issued under this Chapter shall be automatically revoked and suspended for the same period, and in such event, upon appeal be modified or set aside the suspension or revocation of the license issued hereunder shall likewise be automatically affected. All licenses issued hereunder shall expire at midnight on June 30th each year. No license provided for by this section shall be transferred by the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, unless the transfer shall have first made application to the City Council, which application

must be accompanied by transfer fee in the amount of ten per cent (10%) of the initial license fee, as hereinabove set forth, together with satisfactory evidence that the transfer has been approved by the Montana Liquor Control Board."

A person holding a license to sell beer for consumption of the premises at retail may apply for an amendment to the license permitting the holder to sell wine as well as beer. The City may issue such amendment if it finds, on a satisfactory showing by the applicant that the sale of wine for consumption on the premises would be supplementary to a restaurant or prepared food business.

The annual license fee for a license to sell wine on the premises, when issued as an amendment to a beer only license, shall be \$25.00.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1975.

ORDINANCE NO. 359

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY REPEALING SECTION 5-7-10 THEREOF PROVIDING FOR HOURS OF SALE OF LIQUOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson adopted and approved a Resolution No. 355 dated July 21, 1975, approving the repeal of Section 5-7-10 of the City Code of Polson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Chapter 7 of Title V Section 10 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, as set out herein is hereby revoked and repealed;

5-7-10: HOURS OF SALE: no liquor shall be sold, offered for sale or given away upon any premises licensed to sell at retail during the following hours;

- (A) Sunday, from 2:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.
- (B) On any other day between 2:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M.
- (C) On any day of a biennial, general or primary election at which State and National officers are elected, during the hours when the polls are open, but not upon the day of any other election.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and therefor this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 21, 1975.
