

ORDINANCE NO. 363

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER TWO OF TITLE TEN OF THE CITY CODE OF POLSON, MONTANA, 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA

Section 20 Chapter 7 of Title 5 of the City Cod of Polson, 1965, shall be repealed.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 364

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER TWO OF TITLE TEN OF THE CITY CODE OF POLSON, MONTANA, 1965

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA

Section 43 Chapter 1 of Title y of the City Code of Polson, 1975, shall be amended to read as follows:

6-1-43 Petty Theft: (1) A person commits the offense of theft when he purposely or knowingly obtains or exerts unauthorized control over property of the owner, and:

(a) has the purpose of depriving the owner of the property; or purposely or knowingly uses, conceals, or abandons the property in such manner as to deprive the owner of the property; or uses, conceals, or abandons the property knowing such use, concealment or abandonment probably will deprive the owner of the property.

(2) A person commits the offense of theft when he purposely or knowingly obtains by threat or deception control over property of the owner, and;

(a) has the purpose of depriving the owner of the property; or purposely uses, conceals, or abandons the property in such manner as to deprive the owner of the property; or uses, conceals, or abandons the property knowing such use, concealment or abandonment probably will deprive the owner of the property.

(3) A person commits the offense of theft when he purposely or knowingly obtains control over stolen property knowing the property to have been stolen by another, and:

(a) has the purpose of depriving the owner of the property; or  
(b) purposely or knowingly uses, conceals or abandons the property in such manner as to deprive the owner of the property; or  
(c) uses, conceals, or abandons the property knowing such use, concealment, or abandonment probably will deprive the owner of the property.

(4) A person convicted of the offense of theft of property not exceeding One Hundred Fifty and no/100ths Dollar (\$150.00) in value shall be fined not to exceed Three Hundred and no/100th Dollars (\$300.00) or be imprisoned in the county jail for any term not to exceed three (3) months, or both.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and approval.
