ORDINANCE NO. 370

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 01.01 OF ORDINANCE NO. 321 TO CHANGE ZONING OF THE CITY THEREIN FROM R-1, RESIDENTIAL TO C-2, COMMERCIAL BUSINESS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 01.01 of Ordinance No. 321 shall be amended by changing the zoning of the City therein from R-1, residential to C-2, commercial business.

The subject real property which is zoned R-1, residential is situate in the City of Polson, County of Lake, State of Montana, and is more particularly described as follows:

Lots One (1) and two (2), Block Two (2)
Lakeshore Addition

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 371

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY SIDEWALK DISPLAYS EXCEPTING NEWSPAPER STANDS, PHONEBOOTH, TRASH RECEPTACLES OR SPECIAL CITY-WIDE SALE DAYS SANCTIONED BY THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 36 Chapter 1 of Title 9 of the City Code of Polson, 1965 shall read as follows:

9-1-36: It shall be unlawful for any person or business to place or keep any sidewalk displays whether for advertising or merchandising on any legal sidewalk excepting newspaper stands, phonebooths, Council-approved trash receptacles and planters, and displays on special citywide sale days sanctioned by the Chamber of Commerce.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENGE: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety, peace, and health, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and approval.
