ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 TITLE VI OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-3-19 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF DOG ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE VI, Section 6-3-19 shall be amended to read as follows:

6-3-19: FINES DEPOSITED IN GENERAL FUND: (1) Any person convicted of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three hundred and No/100ths Dollars (\$300.00) or a jail sentence of not more than ninety (90) days or by both such fine and jail sentence.

- (2) The punishment established by this Section shall be in addition to and not in substitution of the impoundment provisions or any other disciplinary procedure provided for in this Ordinance.
- (3) All fees, fines, and forfeitures collected hereunder shall be deposited in the general fund of the City and dispensed as the City Council may provide.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
