AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 TITLE I OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 1-18-2 TO SET OUT THE DUTIES OF THE POUNDMASTER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 18 of TITLE I, Section 1-18-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

1-18-2: DUTY OF POWNDMASTER: (a) It shall be the duty of the Poundmaster to take up and impound every dog running at large contrary to the provisions of this Chapter. If an impounded dog be not redeemed within forty-eight (48) hours after said dog is impounded, the Poundmaster shall give notice of such impounding to the owner in the manner prescribed by the Laws of the State of Montana after which, and in conformity thereto, the Poundmaster shall offer the impounded dog for sale, and if no bid, equalling or exceeding the sum of all fees provided for by this Code, including but not limited to those assessed for the impounded dog shall be killed by him. (Ordinance No. 345)

(b) It shall be the duty of the Pound-master to enforce the provisions of Chapter 3 which shall include the authority to issue citations for violation thereof as set forth in Section 6-3-19.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
