

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 TITLE V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 5-7-8 TO PROHIBIT SALES OF LIQUOR, BEER, OR WINE TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF NINETEEN (19) YEARS BY ANY LICENSEE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE V, Section 5-7-8 shall be amended to read as follows:

5-7-8: PROHIBITED SALES: No licensee, or his or her employee, shall sell, deliver or give away or cause or permit to be sold, delivered or given away any liquor, beer or wine to:

- (a) Any person under the age of nineteen (19) years;
- (b) Any intoxicated person or any person actually, apparently or obviously intoxicated;
- (c) A habitual drunkard;
- (d) An interdicted person.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
