AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 TITLE IV OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 4-1-2 REQUIRING INCOMBUSTIBLE WALLS, CORNICES, AND ROOFS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE IV, Section 4-1-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

4-1-2:

INCOMBUSTIBLE WALLS, CORNICES, AND ROOFS REQUIRED: Incombusible walls, cornices,

and roofs are required within the inner fire limits. Every building hereafter erected or enlarged within the inner fire limits shall be enclosed on all sides with walls constructed wholly of stone, brick, hollow building tile, concrete, or other equivalent incombustible materials.

No overhanging cornice shall exceed six inches (6") overhang and cornice coping and sides of all roof structures shall be constructed of incombustible and fire resisting material.

All built-up roofs shall be of either Class A or B rating.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
