ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 TITLE VI OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-3-6 TO MORE CLEARLY DEFINE WHO IS TO DO THE ENFORCING OF THIS CHAPTER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE VI, Section 6-3-6 shall be amended to read as follows:

6-3-6: ENFORCEMENT: The provisions of this chapter shall be enforceable by any duly appointed Police Officer of the City of Polson or any special officer appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council herein called "Officer"; said Officer shall at the expense of the City, provide a suitable and retired place for the impounding of dogs; the location of the Pound shall be published or posted in the United States Post Office in the City and the Poundmaster shall have the general supervision of the City Pound and shall see that the same is conducted in a quiet, reliable and proper manner.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
