AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 TITLE VI OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-3-7 (a) and (b) TO MORE CLEARLY DEFINE WHO IS TO IMPOUND THE DOGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 3 of TITLE VI, Section 6-3-7 (a) shall be amended to read as follows:

6-3-7: IMPOUNDMENT: (a) The Officer shall take up and impound every dog running at large contrary to the provision of this chapter. If an impounded dog be not redeemed within forty-eight (48) hours after said is impounded, the Officer shall give notice of such impounding to the owner in the manner prescribed by the Laws of the State of Montana after which, and in conformity thereto, the Officer shall offer the impounded dog for sale, and if no bid, equalling or exceeding the sum of all fees provided for by this Code, including and keeping, is received therefore, the impounded dog shall be killed by him. (Ordinance No. 345)

CHAPTER 3 of TITLE VI, Section 6-3-7 (b) shall be amended to read as follows:

(b) It shall be the duty of the Officer to enforce the provisions of Chapter 3 which shall include the authority to issue citations for violations thereof as set forth in Section 6-3-17.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
