AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 TITLE VI OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-3-15 TO CHANGE THE WORD POUNDMASTER TO OFFICER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 3 of TITLE VI, Section 6-3-15 shall be amended to read as follows:

6-3-15: PUBLIC NOTICE: Immediately after impounding any dog hereunder it shall be the duty of the Officer to enter upon the records of the Pound in a book to be kept by him for such purpose, the date of the impounding, description of the dog impounded, and a record as to whether or not such dog has been licensed and tagged as required by the Ordinance. Public Notice of the impounding of such dog shall be given by posting one copy of the description of such dog and the date of impounding at the Post Office, and one copy on the bulletin board in the office of the City Clerk. Any such dog not redeemed by the owner thereof within forty-eight (48) hours after posting of such notice by the Officer shall be and is hereby declared to be a public nuisance. The Officer shall immediately thereafter kill or destroy such dog.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
