

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE I, SECTION 1-7-2 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFICES OF CITY JUDGE AND CITY TREASURER BE APPOINTIVE OFFICES AND SETTING FORTH SALARIES THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE I, Section 1-7-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

1-7-2: APPOINTIVE OFFICERS: That Appointive Officers of the City of Polson and their salaries shall be as follows:

City Judge	300.00 per month
Treasurer	375.00 per month
City Attorney	600.00 per month
City Clerk	1081.00 per month
Water Superintendent	1191.00 per month
Sewer Superintendent	1207.00 per month
Street Superintendent	1191.00 per month
Park Superintendent	1168.00 per month
Chief of Police	1218.00 per month
Fire Chief/Building Inspector	1179.00 per month

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
