## ORDINANCE NO. 412

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE I, SECTION 1-7-1 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFICES OF CITY JUDGE AND CITY TREASURER BE REMOVED FROM STATUS OF ELECTIVE OFFICES AND BECOME APPOINTIVE OFFICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE I, Section 1-7-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

1-7-1:

ELECTIVE OFFICERS: The Elective Officers of the City of Polson

and their salaries shall be as follows:

Mayor Council 350.00 per month

80.00 per month

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
