AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING MOTORISTS TO CARRY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE OR OTHER MEANS OF PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ON ALL VEHICLES OPERATED WITHIN THE CITY OF POLSON AND SETTING FORTH PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Chapter 1 of Title 6, Section 50 of the City Code of Polson, 1965, shall read as follows:

Section:

6-1-50

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle within the City of Polson without motor vehicle liability insurance coverage or other means of proof of financial responsibility as set forth in Chapter 6, Title 61, Montana Code Annotated, entitled "Responsibility of Vehicle Users and Owners."

(b) Violation of any provisions of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine not exceeding \$25. Nothing contained herein prevents the prosecution of a person for an offense committed under any other law.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
