ORDINANCE NO. 418

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, TITLE IX OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, 1965, BY AMENDING SECTION 9-7-2 TO AUTHORIZE CITY POLICE OFFICERS TO NOTIFY OWNERS OF TENANTS OF ANY PROPERTY TO REMOVE SNOW AND/OR ICE FROM ABUTTING OR ADJOINING PUBLIC SIDEWALKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE IX, Section 9-7-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

9-7-2: NOTICE TO BE GIVEN: It shall be the duty of the Municipality to give notice to any owner or tenant of any property to remove snow and/or ice, which notice shall be sent by registered mail to the last known address of such owner, tenant or occupant, or shall be by personal service by a City Police Officer to such owner, tenant or occupant. The owner or occupant shall have not more than twenty-four (24) hours from and after receipt of such notice, within which to remove the snow and/or ice as set forth in said notice.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be cecessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
