

## ORDINANCE NO. 436

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TITLE II, SECTION 2-3-2 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, 1965, DETERMINING THE NUMBER AND THE TERM OF SERVICE FOR MEMBERS OF THE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Chapter 3, Title II, Section 2-3-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created a Board of Trustees for the management of the City Library which shall consist of five (5) trustees.

Not more than one member of the Polson City Council shall be at any one time a member of the Board of Trustees.

All of such members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council.

Trustees shall hold their office for five (5) years from the date of appointment and until their successors are appointed. Initially, appointments shall be made for one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) year terms. Annually thereafter, there shall be appointed before July 1 of each year in the same manner as the original appointments for a five (5) year term, a trustee to take the place of the retiring trustee. Trustees shall serve no more than two full terms in succession.

Following such appointments, in July of each year, the trustees shall meet and elect a chairman and such other officers as they deem necessary for one (1) year terms. Vacancies in the board of trustees shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointments.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
