

ORDINANCE NO. 458

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER THREE, SECTION 1 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON BY EXTENDING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS TO A TWO AND ONE-HALF MILE RADIUS OF THE CITY OF POLSON AND RAISING THE ALLOWABLE AGE OF NEW FIREMEN TO FIFTY-FIVE (55) YEARS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

3-3-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

FIRE DEPARTMENT CREATED: There is hereby created and established a Fire Department in and for the City of Polson which shall consist of not less than fifteen (15) or more than twenty-eight (28) volunteer firemen who at the time of their appointment shall be able-bodied individuals between the ages of twenty-one (21) years and fifty-five (55) years of age and having continuously resided for one (1) year within a two and one-half (2.5) mile radius of the corporate limits of the City of Polson or provide documented evidence of at least two years of service in a recognized fire department prior to moving within the two and one-half (2.5) mile radius. A record of a physical examination must be filed with the City Clerk at the time of acceptance as a member of the department.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and approval.
