

ORDINANCE NO. 462

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER THREE, SECTION 1 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON BY EXTENDING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS TO A TWO AND ONE-HALF MILE RADIUS OF THE CITY OF POLSON AND RAISING THE ALLOWABLE AGE OF NEW FIREMEN TO FIFTY-FIVE (55) YEARS INCLUSIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

3-3-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

FIRE DEPARTMENT CREATED: There is hereby created and established a Fire Department in and for the City of Polson which shall consist of not less than fifteen (15) or more than twenty-eight (28) volunteer firemen who at the time of their appointment shall be able-bodied individuals between the ages of twenty-one (21) years and fifty-five (55) years of age inclusive and having continuously resided for one (1) year within a two and one-half (2.5) mile radius of the corporate limits of the City of Polson or provide documented evidence of at least two years of service in a recognized fire department prior to moving within the two and one-half (2.5) mile radius. A record of a physical examination must be filed with the City Clerk at the time of acceptance as a member of the department.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
