

ORDINANCE NO. 465

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF POLSON TO INCLUDE SECTION 3-6-6(I), TITLE III, LIMITING THE USE OF THE CITY DOCK FACILITIES TO FIVE (5) CONSECUTIVE DAYS AND ESTABLISHING FINES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON THAT TITLE III, SECTION 3-6-6(I) SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

3-6-6(I): Dockage of boats at the city dock facilities shall be limited to a period not exceeding five (5) consecutive days followed by a period of at least seven (7) days in which the boat will not be docked at the city facilities.

PENALTY: Boat owners violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first violation and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent violation.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
