

ORDINANCE NO. 466

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF POSTERS AND HANDBILLS ON LIGHT POLES OR OTHER CITY PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF POLSON AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

A. It shall be unlawful for a person to post or display handbills, stickers, placards, posters, political notices or other advertising matter of any kind or description on city property or buildings, traffic control devices, signs, street lighting poles, or power transmission poles.

B. Any person, firm or corporation for or on whose behalf said advertising is placed on said property described above shall be deemed to be a principal in the commission of this offense and shall be subject to a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

REPEALING CLAUSE: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby withdrawn.
