

ORDINANCE NO. 477

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 398 PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATION OF SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES; FOR MODIFICATION OF THE BASIS FOR ASSESSMENT OF CONNECTION FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL REVIEW AND DETERMINATION OF SEWER CHARGES BY RESOLUTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, STATE OF MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Article III, Section 1, of Polson City Ordinance No. 398, adopted by the City of Polson on the 6th day of October, 1980, is hereby amended to provided, as follows:

Prior to commencing any work on a building sewer or a private sewer which is connected to the public sewer, the owner(s) or his agent shall make application to the City of Polson and obtain a written permit from the Superintendant for such work. The permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications, or other information considered pertinent in the judgement of the Superintendent.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, STATE OF MONTANA, as follows:

Article III, Section 2 of Polson City Ordinance No. 398, adopted by the City of Polson on the 6th day of October, 1980, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

There shall be two classes of building sewer permits:

- a) For residential service; and
- b) For commercial, industrial and all other services.

In connection with residential service, the applicant shall be required to pay a minimum \$175 application fee and an additional sum of \$100 for each residential living unit. In connection with commercial, industrial and all other sewer services, the applicant shall be required to pay a minimum \$350 application fee and an additional sum of \$50 for each business entity utilizing the same sewer connection line. In the case of hotel/motel entities, the additional \$50 charge shall be applied to each individual hotel/motel unit.

The City Council of the City of Polson shall have the power and authority to periodically review and adjust sewer connection fees and monthly operation and maintenance fee by resolution for purposes of providing adequate revenue for the operation and use of the City sewer system and for purposes of generating reserve funds for capital improvement and replacement.

All other provisions of the City of Polson Ordinance No. 398 not otherwise amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
