NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that in order to obtain sufficient funds with which to retire all of the said bonds with the interest thereon by the maturity date thereof, there is hereby levied and assessed against all of the property within said Special Improvement District No. 17 an additional assessment of \$_0.76\$ per front foot against all of the property abutting upon the improvements in said Special Improvement District, to be spread over the remaining five (5) years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said additional assessment, together with the regular assessments heretofore made, be certified to the County. Treasurer of Lake County, Montana, to be collected as other taxes and all of said funds placed in Special Improvement District No. 17 Fund for the purpose of retiring said bonds as they shall by their terms become due.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and approval.
