

RESOLUTION NO. 157

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, THAT:

WHEREAS, an immediate public emergency exists because of the fact that, at the time of the adoption of the budget for the fiscal year 1957-1958, no provision was made for the purchase of a police patrol car, and;

- WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of order and of the public peace to purchase such police patrol car, and;

WHEREAS, The City Council, in order to meet such emergency, has arranged for the purchase of such police patrol car, and;

Whereas, there are not sufficient funds to complete such purchase and meet the immediate requirements of the police department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the amount of Twelve hundred Dollars (\$1200.00), the estimated amount required to meet such emergency, be issued against the Maintenance and Operation Fund of the Police Department as emergency warrants, for the purpose of paying for said Police patrol car, and that a public hearing be held on the final adoption of this resolution, as provided by law.
